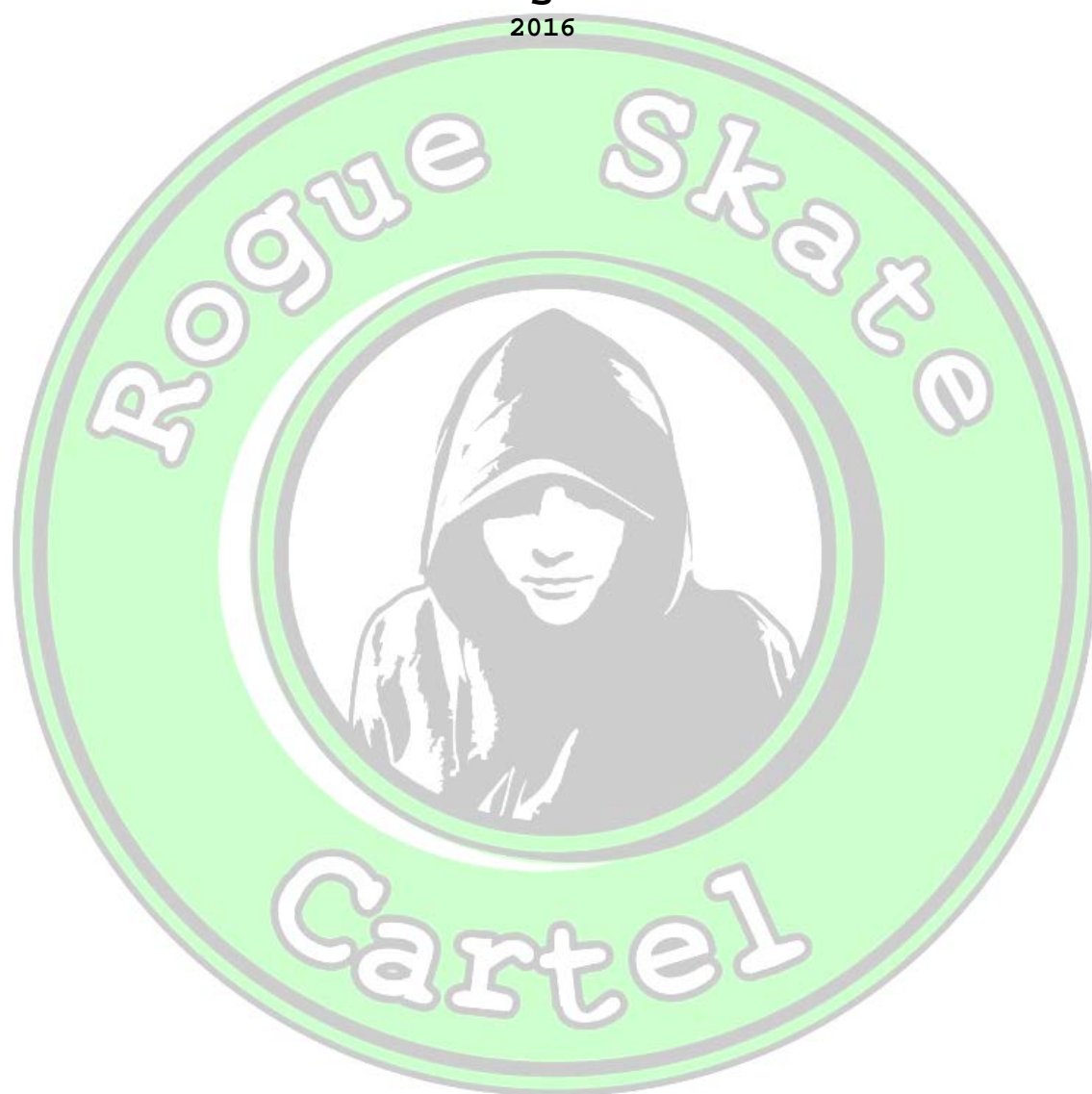

5. I will treat my coaches, teammates, officials, and fans with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, age, or abilities, and I will expect that treatment to be reciprocated.
6. I am participating in this sport to be competitive and to have fun. I will tell the coaching staff and parents if I feel I have been disrespected or if it stops being fun.
7. I deserve to play in an environment that is safe and free of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. I will not use drugs, alcohol, or tobacco, and will expect adults to refrain from their use at our practices and bouts.
8. I recognize the importance of school and will not allow my derby commitment to interfere with my academic success.
9. I will learn the rules of Flat Track Derby, according to the most current JRDA standards.
10. I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or wellbeing of my teammates, coaching staff, officials, parents, or any other attendees.
11. I will not engage in the use of profanity, verbal or physical threats, or any abuse aimed at my teammates, coaching staff, officials, parents, or any other attendees.

1. I will not force my child to participate in ROGUE SKATE CARTEL Junior Derby.
2. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the skaters ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability, injury, or illness that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, skater, or parent.
5. I will respect the officials and their authority during bouts and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches or officials in front of skaters at practice or bouts.
6. I will encourage my child to play to the best of their ability, by the rules, and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
7. I will encourage my child to treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, gender or ability.
8. I will encourage a safe sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol. I will refrain from using drugs, alcohol, or tobacco at practice or bouts.
9. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches for and registered with ROGUE SKATE CARTEL Junior Roller Derby.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Medical: It is the responsibility of the undersigned to insure that the above named person is medically fit to participate in strenuous on-rink or off-rink activities. As stated below, participation in Roller Derby activities presents an inherent risk of injury to person or property. The undersigned certifies that the above named participant has no known conditions that prohibit or limit participation in any derby/skating activities held by or in association with the Rogue Skate Cartel Junior Roller Derby (RSC) or the Junior Roller Derby Association (JRDA). Additionally, the undersigned must have Primary or JRDA medical insurance in place for the participant to cover any expenses related to any potential injury that may arise from their participation in JRDA affiliated programs.

Equipment and Skates: Participants must wear the following mandatory safety equipment during all Roller Derby on-skate activities and practices: Knee, Elbow and Wrist pads and Helmet and Mouth guard. Eyeglasses must have shatterproof lenses. The undersigned must take full responsibility that the above named participant (including self) is wearing the aforementioned safety equipment at all times and that it is properly worn. Only quad roller skates are permitted. All skates must be surface safe, meaning that their use must not gash, indent or blemish the skating surface or and that the skates will not cause injury to property or person(s). All liabilities thereof are undertaken by the undersigned.

Conduct: Spectators (patrons on the premises as a result of your involvement in any JRDA affiliated program) as well as participants must behave in a respectful manner to both person and property. Behavior which could potentially lead to intentional or unintentional bodily injury or injury to property will not be tolerated.

Participation: The above named person is joining a JRDA affiliated program with the intention and goal of completing the prescribed training program, passing the safety skills assessment test and playing the sport of roller derby in accordance with the guidelines and codes of conduct set forth by the JRDA. It is the responsibility of the participant to inform their local program if they choose to withdraw from that program.

Indemnification and Risk Acknowledgement: In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in a JRDA athletic sports program, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and agrees that:

1. The risk of injuries from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury remains; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or other, and I assume full responsibility for my participation and the participation of my minor child(ren) or ward(s); and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Rogue Skate Cartel, JRDA and its local affiliation, venues, coaches, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors and advertisers ("RELEASEES") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss, or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.

I HAVE READ THIS ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, AND I ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY; I FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, AND I UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP MY SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND I SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.

CONCUSSION INFORMATION

This information is offered as part of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention Head's Up: Concussion in Youth Sports Initiative. For more information about concussions and this initiative, visit: www.cdc.gov/ConcussionInYouthSports

A concussion is a brain injury and all brain injuries are serious. They are caused by a bump, blow, or jolt to the head, or by a blow to another part of the body with the force transmitted to the head. They can range from mild to severe and can disrupt the way the brain normally works. Even though most concussions are mild, all concussions are potentially serious and may result in complications including prolonged brain damage and death if not recognized and managed properly. In other words, even a "ding" or a bump on the head can be serious. You can't see a concussion and most sports concussions occur without loss of consciousness. Signs and symptoms of concussion may show up right after the injury or can take hours or days to fully appear. If your child reports any symptoms of concussion, or if you notice the symptoms or signs of concussion yourself, seek medical attention right away.

Symptoms may include one or more of the following:

What can happen if my child keeps on playing with a concussion or returns to soon?

Athletes with the signs and symptoms of concussion should be removed from play immediately. Continuing to play with the signs and symptoms of a concussion leaves the young athlete especially vulnerable to greater injury. There is an increased risk of significant damage from a concussion for a period of time after that concussion occurs, particularly if the athlete suffers another concussion before completely recovering from the first one. This can lead to prolonged recovery, or even to severe brain swelling (second impact syndrome) with devastating and even fatal consequences. It is well known that adolescent or teenage athlete will often under report symptoms of injuries. And concussions are no different. As a result, education of administrators, coaches, parents and students is the key for student-athlete's safety.

If you think your child has suffered a concussion:

Any athlete even suspected of suffering a concussion should be removed from the game or practice immediately. No athlete may return to activity after an apparent head injury or concussion, regardless of how mild it seems or how quickly symptoms clear, without medical clearance. Close observation of the athlete should continue for several hours. The new "Zackery Lystedt Law" in Washington now requires the consistent and uniform implementation of long and well-established return to play concussion guidelines that have been recommended for several years:

"a youth athlete who is suspected of sustaining a concussion or head injury in a practice or game shall be removed from competition at that time"

and

"...may not return to play until the athlete is evaluated by a licensed health care provider trained in the evaluation and management of concussion and received written clearance to return to play from that health care provider".

You should also inform your child's coach if you think that your child may have a concussion. Remember, its better to miss one game than miss the whole season. And when in doubt, the athlete sits out.

Required Equipment Information



Quad Skates - (4 wheels) - When first starting out, the quality of skate is not as important as the price. It's more important to be sure you are interested enough after that first session to stick with it. Once you have decided that you are passionate enough to participate for the long term, purchasing a solid pair of skates will be your next major step. Well-known brands are Riedell and Sure-Grip; ask an experienced skater for more information when you're ready to take this step.



Helmet - A properly-fitting helmet is arguably the most important piece of safety gear you will invest in. We recommend S1 Lifer helmets. They are CPSC Certified (US Skate/Bike) & ASTM Certified (Multiple Impact). Your helmet should fit snugly, almost to the point of discomfort.



Knee Pads - Your knees are very important. You will fall on your knees a lot. Make sure that the knee pad fits tightly enough so that it will not slide off during an impact. Some good name brands are Pro-Tec, Smith, 187, and Triple Eight.



Elbow Pads - Elbow pads should fit snugly just like knee pads. You should treat your elbow pads just as you would knee pads; inspection, care and maintenance are essential for long lasting protection.



Wrist Guards - Wrist guards are designed to protect your hands and wrists. They absorb impacts to the ball of the hand and give support to your wrists. Some guards have splints on either the top or bottom, and some have splints on both. Like all protective gear, your wrist guards need to be sized correctly for optimum support. Inspect your wrist guards frequently.



Mouth Guard - Mouth guards protect against concussions, as well as safeguarding the inside of your mouth and teeth. There are a couple of different styles to choose from. Most skaters use the boil and mold style, (SISU Mouth Guards). You may also have a custom one made by a dentist, or buy a non-molding type. The non-molding style comes in two varieties: protection for the top teeth, or for both top and bottom. Night guards are not acceptable.

Care & Maintenance - You have invested a good deal of money on equipment; make it last as long as possible by taking proper care of it. Be sure to remove your gear from your skate bag after practice and bouts to preserve integrity of your equipment where moisture will occur. Moisture will corrode and destroy the metal alloys that your skate plates are made of. And the material of your pads becomes a breeding ground for bacteria if left wet. You can air-dry your gear effectively to minimize odor, or use some kind of bacteria neutralizing agent to keep your gear from getting too pungent.

Nondisclosure Agreement for Volunteers

The ROGUE SKATE CARTEL allows public access to a majority of its information and inner workings in an ability to promote the sport of Junior Roller Derby; however the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL does consider some of its information "confidential".

This Nondisclosure Agreement is entered into by and between the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL and _____, Official Volunteer, for the purpose of preventing the unauthorized disclosure of Confidential Information as defined below. The parties agree to enter into a confidential relationship with respect to the disclosure of certain proprietary and confidential information.

- 1. Definition of Confidential Information.** For purposes of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" shall include all information that is considered personal in nature and all information or material that has or could have commercial value or other utility in the business in which the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL is engaged.
- 2. Exclusions from Confidential Information.** Official Volunteer obligations under this Agreement do not extend to information that is: (a) publicly known at the time of disclosure or subsequently becomes publicly known through no fault of the Official Volunteer; (b) discovered or created by the Official Volunteer before disclosure by the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL; (c) learned by the Official Volunteer through legitimate means other than from the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL or the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL's representatives; or (d) is disclosed by Official Volunteer with the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL's prior written approval.
- 3. Obligations of Receiving Party.** The Official Volunteer shall hold and maintain the Confidential Information in strictest confidence for the sole and exclusive benefit of the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL. Official Volunteer shall carefully restrict access to Confidential Information to third parties as is reasonably required and shall require those persons to sign nondisclosure restrictions at least as protective as those in this Agreement. The Official Volunteer shall not, without prior written approval of the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL, use for the Official Volunteer own benefit, publish, copy, or otherwise disclose to others, or permit the use by others for their benefit or to the detriment of the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL, any Confidential Information. The Official Volunteer shall return to the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL any and all records, notes, and other written, printed, or tangible materials in its possession pertaining to Confidential Information immediately if the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL requests it.
- 4. Time Periods.** The nondisclosure provisions of this Agreement shall survive the termination of this Agreement and the Official Volunteers duty to hold Confidential Information in confidence shall remain in effect until the Confidential Information no longer qualifies as a trade secret or until the ROGUE SKATE CARTEL sends the Official Volunteer written notice releasing the Official Volunteer from this Agreement, whichever occurs first.
- 5. Relationships.** Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed to constitute either party a partner, joint venture or employee of the other party for any purpose.
- 6. Severability.** If a court finds any provision of this Agreement invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall be interpreted so as best to effect the intent of the parties.
- 7. Integration.** This Agreement expresses the complete understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter and supersedes all prior proposals, agreements, representations, and understandings. This Agreement may not be amended except in a writing signed by both parties.
- 8. Waiver.** The failure to exercise any right provided in this Agreement shall not be a waiver of prior or subsequent rights.

This Agreement and each party's obligations shall be binding on the representatives, assigns, and successors of such party. Each party has signed this Agreement through its authorized representative.
